Unique inquiry framework

We know real learning comes from relating, not repeating. That is why learning at Coomera Anglican College is centred around our unique thINQ inquiry framework.

thINQ uses structured and guided inquiry as the vehicle to develop a curriculum that is both student-centred and student-driven.

It enables teachers to make connections between learners' existing knowledge and their individual learning styles through the context of new experiences.

Inquiry allows each student to be actively involved in their own learning and to take responsibility for that learning. It also recognises each student's unique understanding of the world, and the manner and rate in which they learn.

To build meaning – and therefore understanding – we know students need to acquire and apply a range of skills. Our innovative and contemporary thINQ framework enables students to develop these skills by experiencing authentic situations, such as those offered through our inquiry units.
